INFORMATION / GUIDELINES / AWARDS

AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED FOR THREE CATEGORIES OF CONTESTANTS:

1. Commercial (Best Commercial Ribs)
2. Service Clubs/Organizations (Best Non-Profit Ribs)
3. General Public (People's Choice Awards – judged by the public)

GUIDELINES

- All sauces must be prepared at the event (bottled sauces are acceptable).
- Contestants may arrive at 7:00 a.m. to secure their space.
- Judging will begin at 1:15 p.m.
- Contestants must supply ribs (three slabs or more), all cooking utensils/knives, grills and with heating (gas, wood, or charcoal); tables No more than two ounces of ribs may be given to the public. **Contestants are prohibited from selling any food to the general public except for commercial vendors, who shall have on hand at the event - if they sell their food - all necessary health permits. Commercial vendors are liable for all applicable taxes pertaining to all sales.**

INFORMATION FOR ALL CONTESTANTS

- Set-up, grill (gas or charcoal) drop-off starts at 7:00 am. Grills must be covered.
- Ribs to be judged should be pork spare ribs (three racks or more per contestant cut in TWO-OUNCE pieces after cooking is completed. Containers for judging the ribs will be provided by Redlands Morning Kiwanis. Disposable poly gloves must be used when handling and cutting the ribs into TWO-OUNCE servings.
- You may begin cooking your ribs no later than 8:00 a.m.
- After grilling is completed, you must maintain your product at a safe temperature
- If you don't have your own 6-foot table, there will be tables available for **the rental cost of \$5.00 provided advance notice of five (5) business days is given to Redlands Morning Kiwanis.**
- No alcoholic beverages, smoking within 10 feet of the cooking area, foul language or any disorderly conduct will be tolerated.
- Your area must be kept clean at all times. All trash must be picked up at the end of contest and placed by a trash receptacle that will be provided.
- Ribs must be ready for judging at 1:15 pm.
- There will be no refund of entry fees for any reason.

Rib Cook-Off Rules

1. Meat prepared for judging must be pork spare ribs.
2. Meat must be cooked on location over a fire of wood, charcoal or gas. Contestants may not dig pits. Smoker type barbeques are allowed. Electric ovens or solar ovens are not permitted.
3. Pre-marinated ribs are allowed. Par-boiled ribs are not allowed.
4. All ingredients used in the Cook-Off may be store-purchased, but must be assembled and prepared at the Cook-Off within the designated cooking period.
5. Contestants will be allowed to set up equipment between 7:00 to 8:00 a.m. Cooking may begin immediately after set-up
6. All vehicles must be removed from the Cook-Off area by 8:15 a.m.
7. Each 'chef' may have up to three 'helpers' maximum to comprise their "cooking team."
8. The cooking period will be up to 4 hours. The cooking period will end at 12:30, at which time two-ounce servings shall be cut. The cutting stops at 1:00 p.m., unless otherwise stated.
9. Delivering ribs to the judging area after the cooking period has concluded can be cause for disqualification.
10. Contestants will be supplied a designated cooking area on a first-come, first-serve basis. Contestants will be responsible for supplying ALL of their own supplies: utensils, ingredients, cooking equipment, water, etc. No electricity is provided and generators are not permitted.
11. Each contestant must submit to each judge a TWO-OUNCE portion of ribs in containers provided.
12. Contestants may pass out TWO-OUNCE servings for 'People's Choice' judging.
13. Ribs submitted for judging must be submitted in numbered containers provided by the Cook-Off Committee. Ribs to be judged must be handled with disposable poly gloves and toothpicks provided for two-ounce samplings.
14. Conversing with judges or judges' assistants during the judging period is not allowed.

Note: Upon receipt of your entry form and fee, you will receive a confirmation via email or phone call.

Important: In designing the cooking area, please keep the actual cooking surface (grills, barbeques, etc.) as far away from the actual outside perimeters of the area for safety reasons. Your cooking area must be kept clean and secured from pedestrian traffic or you will be dismissed from the competition.
